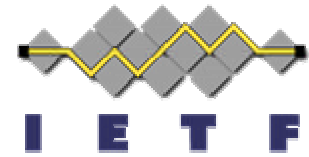


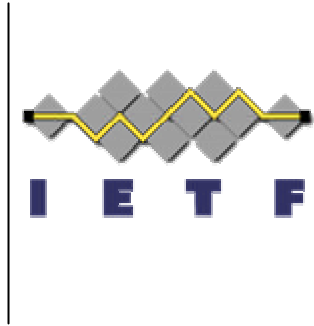

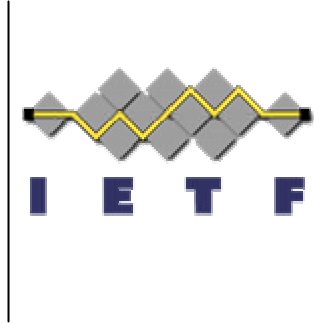

# AdvComm extreme summary



- The IETF legal existence is irregular
  - This is not a feature
- Lots of work by "fellow travellers"
  - Work being done is good
  - Normalizing relationships makes things easier for all
- This is not a trivial problem to get right
  - Preserve features of current system
  - Make it easier to get work done



# The Plan

- The IETF is in need of clearer arrangements
  - Formal organization a part of the answer
  - Must remain open and accountable to the IETF community
- IAB and IESG Chair, with support, run the process
  - Proposals made to IESG and IAB
  - Decisions made by IESG and IAB
    - Ratified at plenary when appropriate
    - IETF Last Call process used when appropriate (documents)
    - Small decisions will "just be made"
